SERVICE RULES, POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Chapter VI

CONDUCT RULES

6.1 Conduct:

- a. An employee of the College shall devote his whole time to the service of the College and shall not engage directly or indirectly in any trade or business or in another institution or any other work which is likely to interfere with the proper discharge of his/her duties. This provision shall not apply to the academic work like giving guest lectures, giving talks and any other work undertaken with prior permission of the Principal.
- b. Every employee shall, at all times maintain absolute integrity and devotion to duty and shall do nothing against the dignity and prestige of the Institute, particularly in his relationship with the Principal, Staff, Students and Visitors to the College.
